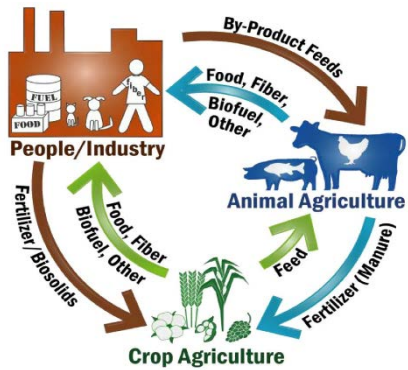

Do you smoke?

Did you know the UK government are trying to pass a law banning branding on packs of cigarettes. If they are successful tobacco manufactures will be forced to sell their cigarettes in plain packets. The motivation behind this decision is to make smoking less appealing to people.

A similar law was passed in Australia in 2012 that has resulted in a fall in smoking rates from 15.1% to 12.8% for people aged 14.

As of January 2015, 22% of adult men and 17% of adult women smoke in Great Britain. The likelihood of smoking in the UK increases with age so that by 15 years of age 8% of school children are regular smokers.

Impressionable children, it is thought, will be less attracted to cigarettes sold in unbranded boxes. The average price for a packet of cigarettes is now £7.98, according to the Tobacco Manufacturers' Association. About 77 per cent (£6.17) on a packet of cigarettes is tax. In 2013-14 the UK government received £9.5 billion in revenue from tobacco tax.

Smoking is the biggest cause of preventable deaths in England.

Every year 80,000 die and over 450,000 are admitted to hospital due to smoking. This places a large strain on the health service and is also a factor in why the government wish to prevent people from taking up smoking or help them quit.
